Year 3 had an exciting time with the Road Safety Team, making a road safety video. They were learning where it is safe to cross, about the Green Cross Code and much more! SATs in Y2 and Y6

Children in years 2 and 6 will be doing their SATs from Monday May 14th. There is a strict timetable in place for Y6 and we have to do the tests on given days. You will find out about this in more detail from the Y6 team.

In Y2, we will start during the week and spread the tests out in to the following week so that we can ensure your child is fully supported.

We have also been selected to be part of a sample of schools doing science tests for Y6. 5 children will be doing a science test during the week that we return after the spring bank holiday. These children will be selected by the Department for Education (DFE) and we will let you know if your child has been chosen when we know.

We have a uniform policy in school to support all parents in being very clear as to what children should wear to school in order to be practical, smart, identifiable and comfortable. This includes black shoes. Some children bring trainers to change in to when playing sport which again is practical, but for those who are now wearing trainers all the time and not bringing their school shoes, they will not be included in any sports activities at break or lunch until they bring their black shoes to change back in to in school. 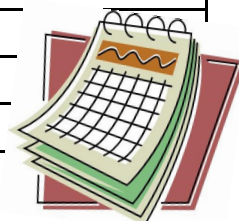
