Parental Survey about Enrichment Activities

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am sending out this survey to find out about your views regarding enrichment activities that we do in school. These activities include things like educational visits, any visitors that come to talk about the curriculum or to lead workshops in school and other things that enhance the children's learning in school but are over and above the normal classroom experiences that your child may have.

We usually ask for voluntary contributions towards any kind of activity described above and make it very clear that, although no child will be excluded from such an activity, without sufficient contributions the activity may not be able to proceed. In the past, any shortfall in contributions has been made up by school but we now find ourselves in a position where this is no longer possible and we would have to cancel any activities where there was a shortfall.

We also understand that for many parents, budgets are very tight and we are grateful for your support. With this in mind, would you please complete this short survey so that we can plan in advance and think carefully about the number of activities we include over the next academic year?
